The Ecumenical Accompaniment Program in Palestine and Israel (EAPPI) is an international, ecumenical program that recruits and dispatches observers (known as Ecumenical Accompaniers- EAs) to several Palestinian towns and villages to monitor the interaction between the Palestinian inhabitants and the Israeli military.

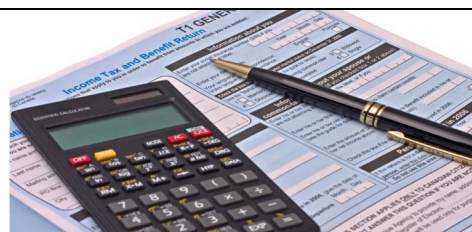

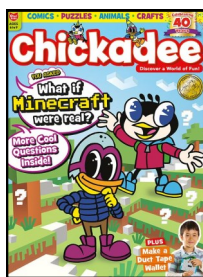
