The Uxbridge Public Library has commissioned this sculpture to recognize the importance of books and libraries— and in remembrance of Alexandra Hartmann, who had worked at the library for 15 years, and was the CEO when she passed away in September 2018.

The sculpture, to be cast in bronze, has been created by Uxbridge sculptor Wynn Walters, who also created the Col. Sam Sharpe statue across the road. It will be installed beside the main entrance, facing the street, but also visible from inside. The sculpture will be financed by donations.






