



Uxbridge Public Library 3D Printer Agreement

All Patrons aged 14 and above must have a signed and completed waiver and have achieved a passing grade on the 3D printer quiz before accessing 3D Printer services. Children under 14 are not permitted to use the 3D printer without an authorized caregiver. Use of the 3D printer requires that you accept the terms of the Library's 3D Printing Policy.

Please read the following policy conditions carefully:

- I accept full responsibility for the 3D printer during my session.
- I understand that permission to use the 3D printer is at the discretion of Uxbridge Public Library Staff and permission may be revoked at any time they deem it necessary.
- I accept responsibility for the cost of repairs or replacements if the 3D printer is in any way damaged or equipment is missing as a result of my use.
- I understand that the 3D printer may be used for lawful purposes **only** and cannot be used to create content that is:
 - Prohibited by provincial law.
 - Obscene or otherwise inappropriate for the Library environment.
 - In violation of another's intellectual property rights or to reproduce materials subject to copyright, trademark or patent projection.
 - Unsafe, harmful, dangerous or poses a threat to the well being of others.
- I understand that anyone not adhering to this agreement or who willfully abuses Library property will have their Library privileges suspended and will be legally and financially responsible for damages.
- I accept that use of the 3D printer is contingent on the successful completion of a quiz to test my knowledge of the equipment prior to use.
- I accept that 3D printing shall be charged at a rate of \$0.10/gram and that

payment should be made prior to the use of the 3D printer. I understand that this price is subject to change at the discretion of Uxbridge Public Library.

- I understand that the terms of this agreement are subject to change at the Library's discretion.
- I accept that staff reserve the right to cancel a print that is failing without first advising me.
- I agree to limit my use of the 3D printer to a 3 hour time frame,
- I understand that the standard booking period is a 3 hour window but I can request a double booking time if needed and it will be approved or denied by staff based on printer availability.
- I agree that any prints not completed within my assigned time frame may be cancelled at my expense.
